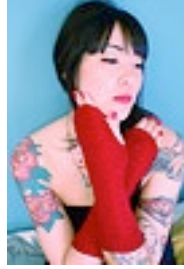


Lana Fingerless Gloves

Chic and sexy



Designed by Nancy Ricci, writer of the blog Getting Purly With It

Materials: 160 yards of worsted weight yarn here shown in Cascade Venezia Worsted
Needle size: US 7
Gauge: 20 stitches over 4" in stockinette stitch
Sizes: One size (approx. 12" long)

Abbreviations:

SSK: slip slip knit

K2tog: knit two together

Kfb: knit in front and back of stitch

Directions

RIGHT HAND GLOVE

Cast on 38 leaving a 10" tail

Step 1:

Row 1: Knit 26, (k1,p1) to end

Row 2: (k1,p1) 6x, knit 25, p1

Row 3: Repeat row 1

Row 4: Repeat row 2

Step 2:

Row 5: K2, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 12

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: Purl

Repeat row 5 to row 8, 6 more times

Step 3: First increase set up

Row 9: K2, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x knit 12

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K2, kfb, k to last 3 stitches, kfb, k2

Row 12: Purl

Step 4:

Row 13: K3, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 13

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: Knit

Row 16: Purl

Step 5 : Second increase set up

Row 17: k3, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 13

Row 18: Purl

Row 19: K2, kfb, k to 3 last stitches, kfb, k2

Row 20; Purl

Step 6:

Row 21: K4, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 14

Row 22: Purl

Row 23: Knit

Row 24: Purl

Repeat row 21 to row 24, 3 more times

Step 7: Last part of the glove and ribbing

Row 25: K4, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 14

Row 26: Purl

Row 27: (k1, p1) to end of row

Repeat row 27, 7 more times.

Bind off loosely, leaving a 20" tail.

Seam your glove, using the mattress stitch technique and leave an opening for thumb.

LEFT HAND GLOVE

Cast on 38 leaving a 10" tail

Step 1

Row 1: (k1, p1) 6x, k26

Row 2: P1, k25, (k1, p1) 6x

Row 3: repeat row 1

Row 4: repeat row 2

Step 2

Row 5: K12, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 2

Row 6: Purl

Row 7: Knit

Row 8: Purl

Repeat row 5 to row 8, 6 more times

Step 3: First increase set up

Row 9: K12, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 2

Row 10: Purl

Row 11: K2, kfb, k to last 3 stitches, kfb, k2

Row 12: Purl

Step 4:

Row 13: K13, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, k3

Row 14: Purl

Row 15: Knit

Row 16: Purl

Step 5 : Second increase set up

Row 17: k13, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, k3

Row 18: Purl

Row 19: K2, kfb, k to 3 last stitches, kfb, k2

Row 20; Purl

Step 6:

Row 21: K14, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 4

Row 22: Purl

Row 23: Knit

Row 24: Purl

Repeat row 21 to row 24, 3 more times

Step 7: Last part of the glove and ribbing

Row 25: K14, (kfb) 4x, (ssk) 4x, (k2tog) 4x, (kfb) 4x, knit 4

Row 26: Purl

Row 27: (k1, p1) to end of row

Repeat row 27, 7 more times.

Bind off loosely, leaving a 20" tail.

Seam your glove, using the mattress stitch technique and leave an opening for thumb.
If desired, block your pieces before seaming.
